### **FAMILY LIFT INFORMATION:**

Mt. La Crosse is offering lift tickets at a special rate of \$20.00 for racers and \$25.00 for family members arriving early for training on Saturday. The racer's bib will serve as their lift ticket on Sunday and Monday. Family members can purchase lift tickets on Sunday and Monday for \$25.00. Training courses will be set on Saturday until 4 PM under the supervision of Bill Patza.

### **ENTRY FEES:**

The entry fee for each team shall be \$380.00. This includes lift tickets and banquet tickets for a maximum of seven (7) racers and one coach.

### **INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION:**

Medalists, as determined by each conference, may participate as individuals in the State Meet. Entry fee is \$70.00 per individual.

### **REGISTRATION:**

We will have registration on Saturday, February 14, 2004, in the SITZPLATZ Room at Mt. La Crosse from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

**A MANDATORY coaches' meeting will be held in the ULLR Room at Mt. La Crosse on Saturday, February 19, at 5:00 PM. ALL TEAMS MUST BE REPRESENTED. If the coach**

cannot attend, a representative from the team **MUST BE PRESENT**. Any team not represented at the Coaches' Meeting, will not receive complimentary lift tickets for coaches. Any registration packets not picked up by 5 PM will be the responsibility of the person speaking as representative for that team. That person must pay the entry fee and will be responsible for the proper distribution of racers' bibs and all pertinent information included in the packet and discussed at the meeting.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Teams shall consist of high school students in regular attendance that has competed as a team member on a regular basis for their respective teams in their conference during the current season.

### **SCORING:**

- A. The time of a racer will determine his/her place in each event. The total of the places achieved by the racer in each of the events will indicate his/her place in the overall standings. The lowest number will represent first place, the second lowest will represent second place, etc. Ties will be broken by adding the racer's times in each event. The lowest times will represent first place, etc.
- B. Individual times of each racer will be recorded and placed numerically. The four best places recorded by each team will become the total place points for that team. The lowest team place points will earn first place, the second lowest combined place points will earn second place, etc.
- C. For determining the overall team standings, the team's place points for each event will be totaled and the team having the lowest number will be the winner with the second lowest number being the second place winner, etc.
- D. Each DNF/DQ finisher will receive 400 race points which will reflect the order of finish for teams with fewer than four racers receiving a time.

### **TEAM COMPOSITION:**

EACH TEAM SHALL CONSIST OF NO MORE THAN SEVEN (7) MEMBERS.

However, no more than six (6) and no fewer than four (4) members of each team may compete in each team event. Running orders may be different for each event.

### **AWARDS:**

**Tickets for the Award Banquet will be on sale starting Saturday during Registration. We are urging family members to purchase their tickets early as a limited number of extra tickets are available. We will offer a lasagna dinner served buffet style. Serving will start at 4:30 PM. The Award Ceremony will follow.**

Medals and trophies will be awarded for the Top Five: Boys & Girls teams, Boys & Girls Individual & Overall.

### **SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS:**

Nomination forms for the Sportsmanship Awards will be in registration packets for coaches. Each coach may submit nominations following the instructions on the form **NO LATER THAN NOON ON MONDAY** to the Race Secretary. TCI Construction of La Crosse is the sponsor of the Sportsmanship Award. A thank you to Chris and Beth Weiss for arranging this new sponsorship.

**NATIONAL TEAM SELECTION:**

The Wisconsin All-State Ski Team will compete in the Eastern Region National High School Meet to be held at Okemo, Vermont, on March 19-20-21, 2004 departing La Crosse on March 17, 2004. Further information on the team selection and the trip will be available at the Coaches' Meeting and Award Ceremony.
