We, the parents of the above-named racer, (or if racer is 18 or older, then, I) recognize that medical treatment may become necessary during my child's (or my) participation with Granite Peak Ski Team, Inc. and to avoid delay of any necessary medical treatment and/or that which would alleviate physical discomfort attendant to physical injury HEREBY EMPOWER the coaches and staff of Granite Peak Ski Team, Inc. or other designated persons to authorize on my behalf recommended medical treatment of my child (or me) by any staff member of any hospital, medical doctor, emergency medical technician and/or other paramedic.
